Seven Types of Death

Seven types of death are mentioned in the Bible.

Spiritual Death

Eph. 2:1; Rom. 5:12; Rom. 6:23; 1 Cor. 15:22

Physical Death. The separation of the soul from the body.

Matt. 8:22; 2 Cor. 5:1-8; Rom. 8:38,39; Phil. 1:21

The Second Death. The perpetuation of spiritual death into eternity; occurs at the beginning of eternity. This is the final judgment of the non-Christian.

Heb. 9:27; Rev. 20:12-15

Operational Death. The failure of the believer

to produce divine good. Producing wood, hay, and stubble instead of gold, silver, and precious stones.

James 2:26

Positional Death. Part of retroactive Positional Truth.

Rom. 6; Col. 2:12,20; 3:3

Temporal Death. This is the believer in a state of carnality, out of fellowship.

Rom. 8:6, 13; Eph. 5:14; 1 Tim. 5:6; James 1:15; Rev. 3:1; Luke 15:24,32

Sexual Death. The inability to procreate.

Rom. 4:16-21; Heb. 11:11,12
